

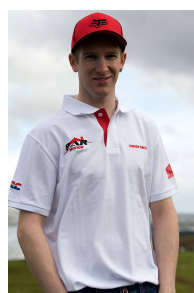
Winning weekend for PAR Honda at Canada Heights

All three riders of PAR Honda produced superb displays at the 7th round of the Red Bull Pro nationals at Canada Heights in Kent.



Brad Anderson – Red Bull Pro Nationals – 1st Overall – 1st MX1 Championship

Brad Anderson was back to winning ways with two wins from two in the MX1 class. From the drop of the flag in qualifying Brad looked in unbeatable form and posted the fastest time just ahead of Russian Gert Krestinov. In moto one Brad managed to keep ahead of Jason Dougan and Krestinov to eventually cross the line some 6 seconds ahead of 2nd place. Moto two was slightly closer but again it was Dougan and Krestinov that put the pressure on the PAR star but Brad held on for the win. Brad now leads the series by 86 points with two rounds remaining.



Martin Barr – Red Bull Pro Nationals – 2nd Overall – 1st MX2 Championship

In MX2 Martin Barr was again solid as a rock and rode sensibly for a strong 2nd overall with a 2-3 race card.

“The 7th round was good for me, I knew I had to ride sensibly and gain as many points as possible and walked away from Canada Heights with a 29 point lead in the championship.”



Scott Elderfield – Red Bull Pro Nationals – 1st Overall – 2nd 2/stroke Championship

Like most Red Bull weekends Scott Elderfield entered two classes the first being the two stroke championship and rode to a well to earned 1st overall in a super competitive class. Scott now finds himself in 2nd overall in the series after his display at Canada Heights. Scott also entered the MX2 class on the Sunday and once again showed great speed on a busy weekend to finish 4th overall.



Luke Hawkins – European championship – 11th Overall – 5th EMX2 Championship

Over in Finland Luke Hawkins continued his journey on the European circuit and found the going tough at the Vantaa track with Scandinavian riders dominating the proceedings. After finishing just outside the top 10 in 11th place the young PAR Honda star still holds onto 5th overall in the championship.

The team now travel to Silverstone for the round 7 of the Maxxis British championship on Sunday 29th August.
